

Care Instructions for Bermuda Lawns

Watering:

- When temperatures are above 80 degrees water within 1 hour of installing the first piece of sod.
- Water newly installed sod for 1 hour and monitor the soil everyday to ensure that the soil is saturated to a depth of 1 inch.
- For the first 2 weeks water twice a day in early morning and in the afternoon.
- Avoid watering late in the evening or overnight to prevent fungal growth.
- If temperatures are cooler watering once a day is sufficient
- Every yard is different, it is up to you to determine the correct watering times that will adequately irrigate your lawn.

Mowing:

- The first mowing of the new sod should be within the first 2 weeks. Pull up on a corner of the piece of sod, if there is resistance from the newly developed roots then it is ready to be mowed.
- Bermuda likes to be maintained between 1" – 1 1/2" and should be mowed every 7 - 10 days.

Fertilization:

- Upon installation, apply a starter fertilizer to help promote root growth and establishment.
- Do not fertilize between September 1st and April 15th .
- Fertilize every 6 weeks throughout the summer.
